SCHOOL PROCEDURE	Students will exit the building and move to predesigned areas (most likely the North Field) under teacher direction. In case of inclement weather, the school has arrangements to use other nearby facilities (most likely the LDS chapel adjacent to the school).	Students will remain in locked classrooms under teacher direction until the building is cleared by police.	Students will “duck, cover, and hold” under their desks during the earthquake. As soon as it is safe to move, students will follow FIRE procedures.	<p>Blizzard: Decisions to keep children at school will be based on road conditions. If students are kept at school, they will “shelter-in-place” using emergency food and blankets stored at the school, as needed.</p> <p>Chemical Spill: Decisions to keep children at school will be based on safety. If students are kept at school, they will “shelter-in-place” using emergency food and blankets stored at the school, as needed.</p>	<p>Students already on the bus will be kept on the bus if road conditions are impassible.</p> <p>If limited transport is possible, buses are directed to drop children off at the closest available school.</p> <p>The bus driver will contact the school/district office by radio to communicate location of students.</p>
