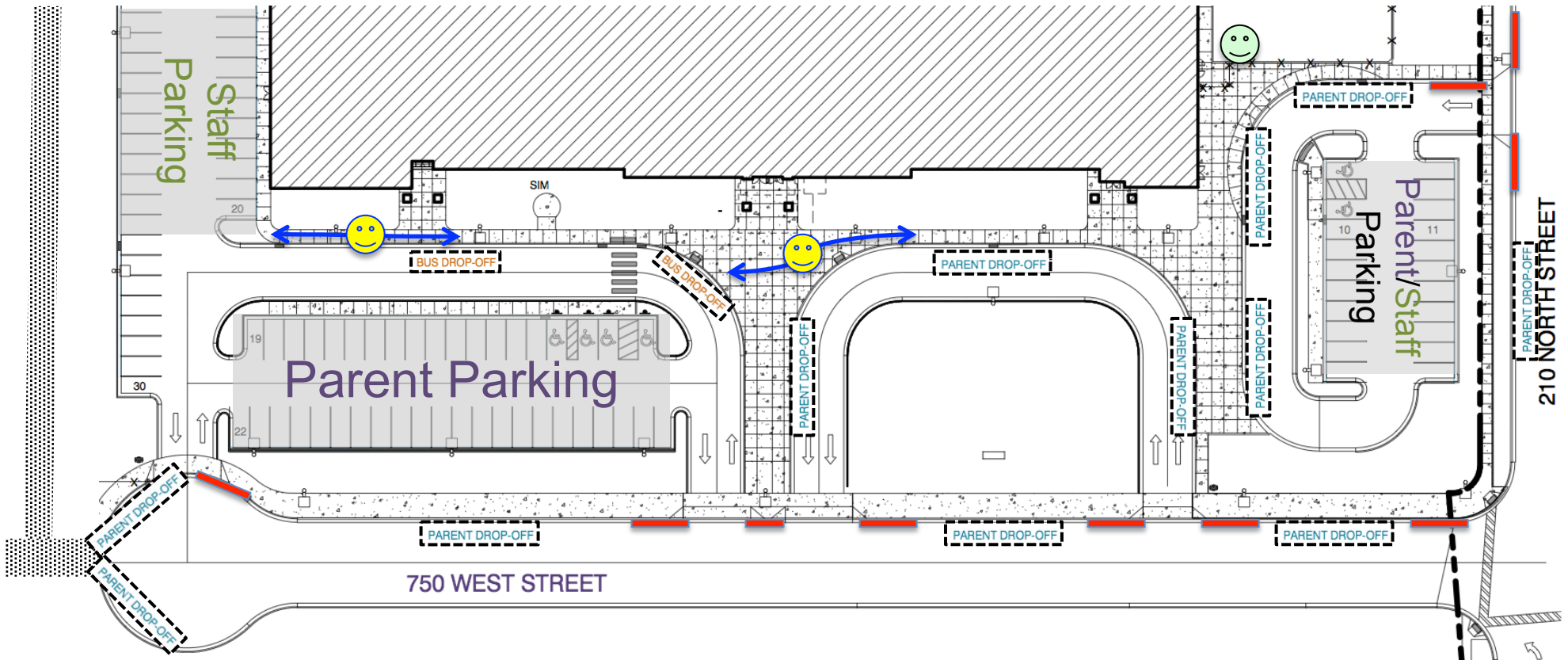


## Thunder Ridge Drop-off, Pick-up, and Parking Guidelines

Dear Parents,

The staff, the School Community Council, and the PTA work hard to make plans that promote student safety at school. One of the most important parts of our safety efforts is to develop and communicate to parents a plan for how students should be transported to and from school in an orderly manner. Even though this plan may result in slight inconveniences for you or your child may have to walk on the sidewalks a little further, please follow the guidelines below. Please do not seek to be the exception and ignore these guidelines because doing so creates unpredictable and unsafe conditions here at school. Thanks!



### Important Guidelines

- Please do NOT enter the **"BUS DROP-OFF"** zone by the north doors, even for just a minute. We have buses coming and going at five different times every day.
- Please do NOT park and leave your car in the two **"PARENT DROP-OFF"** zones by the south doors, even for just a minute. It stalls the flow of traffic.
- When using the **"PARENT DROP-OFF"** zones, pull as far forward as possible so other cars can fill in the spaces behind. Students should quickly exit/enter the car.
- The district constructed a walking path on the North Field (⊞) that students who are walking/biking from neighborhoods north and west of school should use to move to/from the playground. Students should NOT walk in the **"Staff Parking"** area north of the gym and parents should NOT use this area to drop off students.
- Please not wait in your car at — spaces because it blocks traffic and blocks the view of other drivers who are trying to safely pull in/out of the drop-off areas.
- During each transition time (8:00, 9:15, 2:15, 3:30) the school will have two staff members doing safety watch (😊). Please politely accept any direction they give.
- There will always be one Kindergarten teacher doing safety watch inside the Kindergarten playground (😊) during each K transition time (9:15, 12:00, and 3:30).
- If necessary, like during events when many parents come to school, you are also welcome to use the sides of the street on 750 W for additional parking.
